**We urge you to read these policies with the student(s) in your family and sign the last page of this document to verify that you received and understand the policies and procedures. These policies and procedures are in effect for all current students and apply for the duration of their enrollment. Any future changes or updates will be presented to parents for acknowledgements.**

**Please read and retain the following policies and procedures carefully; then sign and return the last sheet along with your child on the next school day.**

## Mission Statement

“The Sunday Islamic School intends to provide a place and environment for students to acquire and practice the Islamic education. We attempt to assist our children to follow the Islamic way of life while living in non-Muslim environment.

## Admission/Enrollment

- The child should be at least 3 years of age by September 1 to be eligible for enrollment in Level 1.
- The registration application form must be completely filled out for the new students and updated by current information for old students.
- The student may begin school as soon as the registration form has been filled out.
- If a Child is requested for admission in a class higher than his/her age group, the School/teachers will conduct a comprehensive examination based upon the requested class’s curriculum to validate the student’s knowledge. The teacher must be satisfied by the student general knowledge to be able to fit in the requested grade.

## School Hours

Regular school: 10:30 AM – 1:30 PM typically from the beginning of September to the end of May.

**NOTE:** Students are required to attend the general assembly at 10:30 AM and to pray Dhuhr Salah in congregation in the ICBN and parents are strongly recommended to join with their children. Let us practice what we teach our children. Dhuhr Salah is held at 1:15 PM on Sundays.

## Drop off and Pickup

In order to ensure student’s safety, we require that parents to Drop off and pick up students **ONLY** inside the Islamic Center.

## Attendance

In order for a student to receive maximum benefit from his/her Islamic education, weekly school attendance is required. However, unforeseen circumstances and illnesses may require the student to be absent on certain occasion. Therefore, the Sunday Islamic School has adopted the following attendance regulations:

- In all cases, a **call** from the parents must be accrued to the center before 11:00am stating the purpose of the absence. Call 309-664-0304.
- A note must be provided to the teacher in case a student needs to be picked up before the formal ending of school.
- A student who arrives in class after the Assembly is been considered tardy.
- Parents have the responsibility to bring their children to the Islamic school on time.
- If a student is tardy or absent, it is their duty to get the assignment of the week and prepare for the following Sunday's class.

## Books

- The School will provide the students books for the academic school year.
- Students are expected to take care of the books and write their names on them.
- Students are required to bring all the books to school on every school day unless the teacher decided to keep the books at school.
- School will charge the cost of the books in case second copy needs to be acquired

## Discipline

In order to maintain order the school administration will use the following disciplinary measures:

- For first offenses the student shall receive a verbal warning.
- Further offenses will be dealt with by contacting the parents and or giving a detention.
- If a student has chronic discipline problems, administrators and teachers will conference with parents to formulate an action plan so that the student may be more successful in school

## Dress Code

In order to preserve the sanctity of the Sunday Islamic School, we shall require all students to wear appropriate dress while in the center. We ask that parents ensure that students maintain a proper standard of dress, which displays respect for center's etiquettes.

- Girls are required to have/wear a hijab or other covering for their heads.
- Girls are required to wear long sleeve shirts.
- It is recommended for both boys and girls to wear modestly loose clothing.
- Shorts are not allowed.
- Sport caps are not allowed.
- Any clothing materials displaying inappropriate images are not allowed
- We trust you parents to be the role model for your kids and follow the same roles when you are on the Islamic Center premises.

## School Supplies

School supplies will be determined by each class teacher.

## Homework

Assignments are to be completed at home vary according to grade level and subject area. Homework may be assigned to enable students to expand on the skills and concepts taught in class, and to gain a more thorough understanding as a result of additional independent study.

- It is student's responsibility to complete and submit assignments on time.
- It is student's responsibility to make-up all work in case of being absent from class.
- Parents are responsible to ensure that their child does complete the assigned work each week.
- Parents are also expected to regularly monitor the homework, which provides a good overview of how and what the student is doing in various subjects. Doing proper homework could also have a direct positive effect in the child's learning, achieving grades and their Islamic knowledge.
- Incomplete homework will have negative effect on the student's final grade. We wish to provide an opportunity for the students to follow through with responsibilities and experience the success of independent learning. Parents should expect homework each week and inquire of its nature. It is recommended to spread the homework over the course of the week instead of 1 day.

## Grading and Report Cards

Our purpose for grading is to provide parents with needed information about the child's efforts and academic achievements. Grades are most important for children to determine their academic standing. As parents and teachers we certainly need to help our children set goals for improvement of their academic strengths and weaknesses.

- Each academic year consists of a fall and a spring semester. At the end of the year a final examination will be administered to all students.
- Final report card will be provided to every student at the end of the school year.

## Personal Property

It is responsibility of parents to keep track of all personal items student bring to school each day.

- Students are expected to label all their school supplies, belongings and accessories as it help the lost & found scenarios.
- Personal property such as collection cards, walkmans, radios, toys etc. are considered nuisance items and are not permitted at school.
- Students are required to place their shoes on the shoe racks and hang their coats on the hangers.

## Visitors

Guests are always welcome at the Islamic Sunday School. A few guidelines are to be followed in order to insure a successful experience for all those involved.

- A visitor or friend may visit only if prior permission is obtained from the administration.
- The visitor or friend needs to dress and act appropriately within the Center.
- As always, parents are most welcome at any time to sit in and listen during classes and speak with the administration or teachers.
- Parents may also contact the administration to conference with a teacher.
